

GENUS PETROCHELIDON.

234. **Cliff Swallow.**

(Petrochelidon lunifrons.)

A regular summer resident, somewhat irregularly distributed, being abundant at some points and absent from others. Breeds in colonies under the eaves of barns, etc. throughout its range in the Province.

Arrives early in May, departs in August.

GENUS HIRUNDO.

235. **Barn Swallow.**

(Hirundo erythrogaster.)

A common summer resident, breeds throughout its range in the Province.

Arrives about the end of April, departs early in September.

GENUS TACHYCINETA.

236. **White-breasted Swallow.** (Tree Swallow.)

(Tachycineta bicolor.)

A common summer resident, breeding in holes in the side of buildings, nest boxes, etc., throughout its range in the Province.

Arrives quite early in April, departs about the end of September

GENUS CLIVICOLA.

237. **Bank Swallow.** (Sand Martin)

(Clivicola riparia.)

An abundant summer resident, breeding in colonies in holes in sandbanks throughout its range in the Province.

Arrives about the beginning of May, departs about the middle of September.

GENUS STELGIDOPTERYX.

238. **Rough winged Swallow.**

(Stelgidopteryx serripennis.)

A rare summer resident of our southern border, where it has been found as far east as Toronto.

GENUS AMPELIS.

239. **Bohemian Waxwing.**

(Ampelis garrulus.)
