THE HARVEST OF AN IMPORTANT MONEY CROP OF FARMS IN EASTERN CANADA

The income from the apple orchard is an important addition to the revenue of many Ontario and Eastern Canada farms. In recent years there has been a remarkable growth of cooperative enterprise in the marketing of this crop. The old-time apple buyer is not the important man he was some years ago, and apple orchards sold in bulk—so much for the crop—are not to be had to-day as they were years ago.
