

Mr. Bell, from the Committee of the whole House to whom was referred the Bill for applying a further sum of money towards the building and completing of a Common Gaol for the District of *Montreal*, and to whom was also referred the report of the Special Committee on the said Bill, reported the amendments made thereto; and he read the Report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's table, where it was again read once throughout.

And the said amendments being again severally read, and the question of concurrence being separately put upon each, they were agreed unto by the House.
