Mr. Bell, from the Committee of the whole Houle to whom was referred the Bill for applying a further fum of money towards the building and completing of a Common Gaol for the Diftrict of *Montreal*, and to whom was also referred the report of the Special Committee on the faid Bill, reported the amendments made thereto; and he read the Report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's table, where it was again read once throughout.

And the faid amendments being again feverally read, and the quefion of concurrence being feparately put upon each, they were agreed unto by the Houfe.

On motion of Mr. Papineau, fenior, feconded by Mr. Durocher;

ORDERED, that the faid Bill, as amended, be engroffed.

The order of the day, for the Houle to refolve itfelf into a Committee of the whole Houle, on the engroffed Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled, "An Act to prevent the abule of oppositions afin d'annuller, afin de distraire, and afin de charge," being read;

The House resolved itself into the faid Committee.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. St. Dizier took the Chair of the Committee.

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair ;

And Mr. St. Dizier reported, that the Committee had come to a refolution, which he was directed to fubmit to the Houfe, whenever it should be pleafed to receive the fame.

ORDERED, that the report be now received.

And he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's table, where it was again read once throughout.

The
