Begun and holden at Halifax, on **THURSDAY**, the sixth Day of **FEBRUARY**, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twelve, in the Fifty Second Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord **GEORGE** the Third; by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of *Great Britain* and *Ireland* **KING**, Defender of the Faith, and of the United Church of *England* and *Ireland*, on Earth the Supreme Head.

**H**IS Excellency Sir **GEORGE PREVOST**, Baronet, then Lieutenant Governor having, by his Proclamation (hereunto annexed) dated the 14th August, 1811, dissolved the last General Assembly, and called a new Assembly; and the said Assembly, by virtue of two subsequent Proclamations: One by his Hon<sup>r</sup> **ALEXANDER CROKE**, President and Commander in Chief, bearing date the 20th day of September following; and the other by his Excellency the Lieutenant Governor Sir **JOHN COAPE SHERBROOKE**, K. B. dated the 4th day of November last, (which Proclamations are also hereunto annexed) having been prorogued, and afterwards appointed to meet and sit at Halifax, this day, being the sixth day of February, in the year 1812, the following are the names of the Members returned by the several
