THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY,

The Province of NOVA-SCOTIA,

Begun and holden at HALIFAX, on THURSDAY, the sixth
Day of FEBRUARY, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twelve, in the fifty
Second Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third; by the
Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland KING,
Defender of the Faith, and of the United Church of England and Ireland, on
Earth the Supreme Head.

HIS Excellency Sir GEORGE PREVOST, Baronet, then Lieutenant Governor
having, by his Proclamation (hereunto annexed) dated the 14th August,
1811, dissolved the last General Assembly, and called a new Assembly; and the said
Assembly, by virtue of two subsequent Proclamations: One by his Hon'r ALEX-
ANDER CROKE, President and Commander in Chief, bearing date the 20th day
of September following; and the other by his Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor
Sir JOHN COAPE SHERBROOKE, K. B. dated the 4th day of November last, (which
Proclamations are also hereunto annexed) having been prorogued, and afterwards
appointed to meet and sit at Halifax, this day, being the sixth day of February,
