The Honorable Mr. Attorney General *Macdonald* reported from the said Committee, That they had drawn up an Address accordingly; and the same was read, as followeth:—

To the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty.

May it please Your Majesty,

We, Your Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Commons of Canada, in Parliament assembled, humbly approach Your Majesty for the purpose of representing:—

That the interests of Canada require that the Seat of the Provincial Govern-

ment should be fixed at some certain place.

That we have resolved to appropriate the sums requisite for providing the necessary Buildings and accommodation for the Government and the Legislature, at such place as Your Majesty may see fit to select.

And we therefore humbly pray Your Majesty to be be graciously pleased to exercise the Royal Prerogative by the selection of some one place as the perma-

nent Seat of Government in Canada.
