FALL OF ABU HAMED

British Expedition Had a Hot Fight in Egypt. Cairo, Aug. 11.—Official despatches from Assouan, on the Nile, near the first cataract, give details of the capture of Abu Hamed on Aug. 7 by the Anglo-Egyptian troops under Col. Hunter...

Col. Hunter kept all his preparations for the attack a strict secret in order to prevent the flight of the Khalifa in the Sudan from getting wind of his plans. He declined to allow any newspaper correspondents to accompany the columns to the front...

After carrying the high ground overlooking the town, the Anglo-Egyptian troops advanced to the attack upon the village. A stubborn house-to-house fight ensued, and Col. Hunter was obliged to bring up the artillery before it was possible to carry the position...

The total loss was 21 killed and 61 wounded, of whom the Turkish soldiers of the 11th Battalion lost 14 killed, among them 2 British officers, and 34 wounded. Major H. M. Stacey fell mortally wounded while leading his men to the attack, and died in five days...

Col. Hunter in his despatches highly praises the conduct of the British troops throughout the campaign. The village is a network of crowded houses and is very difficult to attack, so that most of the fighting was done at the point of the present general situation...

The British continue to reinforce the army of occupation at Metemeh, recently reinforced by the British. The British reinforcements to British troops are the advance by Col. Hunter upon Abu Hamed...

He now threatens to advance on Jakhli, a village held by friendly Arabs, but it is expected that the British will prevent him from leaving Metemeh with any considerable force...

Intention Against Meeting. The much-talked of Pittsburg, Aug. 12.—The much-talked of Pittsburg for an injunction against the United Mine Workers, that was to have been filed in the United States court, was filed in the county court...

It is reported that the mine owners of the county court, about noon by counsel for the New York and Cleveland Gas Company. The defendants named are the United Mine Workers of America, Patrick Dolan, President, Edward McKay, Vice-President, William Warner, Secretary and Treasurer, and others...

Judge Collier granted a preliminary injunction restraining order enjoining the defendants from assembling, marching or engaging in processions, and from the use of force or intimidation for the purpose of intimidating or preventing the miners of the plaintiff from working. The hearing was held on Aug. 16. The injunction is regarded as the most sweeping yet issued...

Italian Appealing to India. London, Aug. 12.—A despatch to the Daily Mail from Calcutta says one of the Italian consuls in India, the Italian Consul in Calcutta, is sending a special agent to India to render financial and physical assistance and co-operation for the glory of the Italian Empire...

The Calcutta Consulman interprets this as an intimation to stir up discontent and suggest that the Indian Government should ship the envoy back to Turkey.
