No. III.

OTTAWA, April 29.—At my usual occupation, you see, endeavoring to frame a letter of interest to the readers of the ACADIAN concerning the Dominion House of Commons in particular and things talked about in and around the Commons and Ottawa in general.

The Government has with commendable zeal brought forward and heaped to the members of the House and the public the blue books.

The Dominion booksellers have been lately as a deputation, and have written on the different Members of the Government with regard to the change in the tariff in the line of book and stationery.

A change is also wanted with regard to postal facilities with the United States. The way the arrangements are now with the United States and Canada, all mail matter posted in the former country is delivered in Canada free of extra charge.

The "army" of Canada is beginning to appropriate a good deal of the expenditure on Militia and Defence.

The result of the Cabinet consideration, the new Committee of Agriculture, which has been substituted for the Committee of Immigration and Colonization, will be composed largely of farmers, and those interested in farming.

No final action has as yet been taken by the Government with regard to the construction of public buildings for post office, custom house, etc., in Kentville.

On Wednesday last Mr Jones moved and Dr Borden seconded for all correspondence between the Department of Railways and the Halifax Chamber of Commerce respecting the rights of the W. & A. Railway Co. under their agreement with the government, dated September, 1879.
