The Foreign Office has made pubc a letter of Viscount Grey to the American Embassy here, requesting Ambassador Gerard in Berlin to convey to the German Government the a most formal protest against the execution of Capt. Fryatt by the German authorities in Belgium. This execution, says Viscount Grey's letter, the British Government can only describe as the judicial murder of a British subject held as prisoner of war by the German Government, under conditions in direct violation of the law of nations and the usages of war.

APPOINTED GOVERNOR GENERAL.

LONDON, Aug. 10. General Kuropatkin has been ap ointed Governor General of Turkes tan, a Central News despatch from Petrograd to-day states. General Kuropatkin, who was Chief-in-Command of the Russian forces in Manchuria, at the beginning of the Russopanese war, was appointed Comander-in-Chief of the Russian arnies on the northern front in February 26, and succeeded General Nichlas Ruzski.
