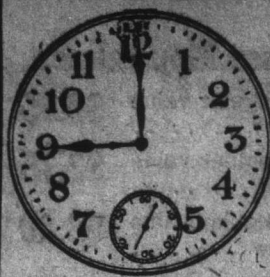

The crew took to the dories and the schooner sank in twenty minutes.
