CORBETT GETS GROGGY. Corbett looked worried as he teed

the ropes, putting right and left swings to the jaw. Corbett failed to land at any stage and was dazed. Nelson kept pegging away, sending in his usual volley of right and left jolts to the face.

"FOUGHT LIKE A WILD MAN." In the eighth Corbett lunged out wildly with left, and they mixed it in the center.
