STRAWBERRIES WERE PLENTIFUL

Retailed at From Eight to Ten Cents a Box Today.

BUTTER AND EGGS DOWN

Jats Were Very Scarce—Hay Sold at \$13 to \$14.50 a Ton—Other Quotations on London Market.

Almost every farmer had his quota of strawberries this morning. The supply of good fruit was very good. The retail price was \$8 to \$10 a box, and the wholesale three boxes for a quarter.

Butter and eggs took second place in the market. The supply was not very large. The wholesale dealers are paying \$8 to \$9 for butter and practically the same price for eggs. A few baskets of eggs were sold in the dairy hall, but mostly a pound of butter.

A dozen loads of hay went at the prevailing price, \$13 to \$14.50 a ton. Only two loads of straw were offered. They sold from \$7 to \$8 a ton.

Oats are scarce.

Some of the dealers are rather hard pressed for a supply of oats. The farmers are busy in the fields and are bringing in very little. Only two loads went off this morning. The dealers were very keen for these, and bid up to fancy figures, which, however, are far above the regular quotations. The loads sold for \$12.50 and \$13.50 per cwt.

There was a fair quantity of green peas offered for sale by the market gardeners. These sold for 25c per quart retail, and the wholesale, new beans are still rather high at 5c a bushel and 9c to 10c a dozen. Some new cabbages, although rather small, brought 5c each.

The only thing brought in by the butchers this morning was in the dressed pork line. A few loads were brought in and sold for \$12 per cwt.
