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- 4. At contains full and complete instructions in Harmony and Thorough-base, subjects allimportant, and yet scarcely hinted at in other Piano-forte Methods.
- 5. It instructs the student in the principles of vocal accompaniment, including playing from a vocal score, thereby preparing him to be an efficient church organist, when necessary; this too, is peculiar to this work.



- 6. It is the only piano school which treats at any length, on the proper use of the so-called. and much abused, "loud pedal." On this subject alone, the work is of priceless value to the young
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
