Justice Drysdale has filed judgement on the application in the case of the Cumberland Railway and Coal Co., vs. McDougall et al. to continue injunction until the trial. His Lordship examined with care the affidavits produced by defendants counsel in answer to the case made for the injunction and was of opinion the case had not and counsel in answer to the case had not injunction and was of opinion the case had not injunction and was of opinion the case had not been met. He was satisfied that since the strike and since plaintiff company have been endeav-oring to carry on their works by the hiring and introduction of men for that purpose, defendants have been parties to an organized system of intimidation and coercion intended and having for its object the prevention of employment by the company of men, and the prosecution of work by men engaged for work about the company's property upon terms mutually agreed upon between the company and such men. In his opinion a case had been made for a continuation of the injunction until the trial.
