Excresences fast are now trying to shoot; Some put out a tail, some develope a foot; Some set up a mouth; some strike down a root Which nobody &c.


Some wishing to walk-manufacture a limb :-Some rig up a fin, with intention to swim Some open an eye, some remain dark and dim Which nobody &c.



A very tall pig-with a very long nose Sends forth a proboscis: right down to his toes And then; by the name of an ELEPHANT goes Which nobody &c.




An ape (with a pliable thumb and big brain) When, the gift of the yab he had managed to gain As LORD OF CREATION established his reign; Which nobody &c.!
