proposed a similar proposal to the  
Democratic Republic of Vietnam.

In this connection we may want  
attention to the discussions in October 1954  
in the Joint Commission in which  
only basis of the Geneva-Plan Agreement  
agreed to find ways and means to settle  
positive problems. We are sure that the  
Royal Government is aware that according to  
the opinion of "All India Association", which  
the matter was under investigation, was fed by  
mainly terminating any discussions between  
the Socialist Government and the capitalist

The International Commission has sent a  
copy of the Government of the D.R.V.  
which is engaged in a long negotiation.
