INGRA HAS ALREADY GIVEN SUBCONTRACT TO MARINE INDUSTRIES LTD FOR BEKHME HYDRO PROJECT IN IRAQ. HAVE HIGHLIGHTED ACCESS TO EDC LINES OF CREDIT BY CDN FIRMS WHICH SHOULD, IN TIME, GENERATE MORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR CDN SUPPLIERS.

Initiated and designed a full-page supplement in Yugoslavia's most influential business newspaper Privredni Pregled, which outlined EDC financing available in third countries, equipment trade shows in Cda, and suggested forms of cooperation.

Firms contacted about mission have been enthusiastic about meeting and cooperating with Cdn. firms in third countries esp. USSR, Middle East, Africa. We are working with some mission members to identify Cdn partners for USSR projects.
