The DFAIT Science and Technology Program assists Canadian-based research institutions and firms in participating in international research networks and in gaining access to international sources of advanced knowledge and technology world-wide. The S&T Program is delivered by a network of S&T officers in Canadian missions abroad, and at DFAIT headquarters by the Science and Technology Division (TBR). The program's client base is the Canadian S&T community that includes federal and provincial SBDAs (Science-Based Departments and Agencies), university research centres, and the business R&D sector.

***Science and Technology Counsellors Network***

Canada's Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade, as an essential component of its S&T Program, supports a network of Science and Technology Counsellors (S&TCs) in London, Paris, Tokyo, Brussels (EU), Berlin, Paris, Tokyo and Washington, as well as a delegate at the Permanent Delegation of Canada to the OECD (Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development) in Paris.

***Science and Technology Counsellors' Canada Tour, March 2001***

Once every year, Canada's Science and Technology Counsellors present to the Canadian S&T community an overview of the most recent Science and Technology developments in their host countries, or international organizations. The Canada Tour provides an opportunity for S&TCs to meet with key Canadian clients and partners in international science and technology and promote the S&TC network services to the Canadian scientific community at the government, university and industry level. This year, the Tour is extending its participation to Officers with Science and Technology responsibilities coming from Stockholm, Helsinki, Madrid, Moscow and Sao Paulo.
