

Treaty Series 1945, No. 22: Financial Agreement between Canada and Belgium, with an Exchange of Notes. Signed at Ottawa, October 25, 1945.

Treaty Series 1945, No. 23: Financial Agreement between Canada and Czechoslovakia. Signed at Ottawa, March 1, 1945.

Treaty Series 1945, No. 27: Financial Agreement between Canada and Norway, with an Exchange of Notes. Signed at Ottawa, June 25, 1945.

Treaty Series 1946, No. 3: Convention concerning the protection against accidents of workers employed in loading or unloading ships, adopted by the General Conference of the International Labour Organization on April 27, 1933. Canadian ratification deposited April 6, 1946.

Treaty Series 1946, No. 21: Financial Agreement between Canada and Belgium, with an Exchange of Notes. Signed at Ottawa, May 8, 1946.

Treaty Series 1946, No. 22: Agreement between Canada and Australia for air services between the two countries. Signed at Ottawa, June 11, 1946. (See Section 2.1)

Treaty Series 1946, No. 23: Exchange of Notes between Canada and Belgium constituting an agreement in settlement of war claims. Signed at Brussels, May 21 and July 18, 1946. (See Section A.4)

Treaty Series 1946, No. 24: Agreement between Canada and Newfoundland on air transport between the two countries. Signed at St. John's July 29, 1946. (See Section 2.14)

Conference Series 1946, No. 2: Report of the Canadian Delegates to the 4th Assembly of the League of Nations held at Geneva, April 8-18, 1946. (See Section 2.12)

Colonel Tseng Chin-Chi, Military Attaché at the Chinese Embassy has taken over the duties of Mr. Attache.

Lieutenant Harry Oliver Anderson has been appointed Attaché at the Legation of Norway.

Mr. Chen Tseh-min has been appointed Attaché at the Chinese Embassy.

Mr. George S. Vincent, formerly Deputy Director of the United Kingdom Information Office in Ottawa, has succeeded Mr. H.M.K. Loret as Director. The latter has been transferred to the Office of British Information Services in New York. Mr. Peter H. Bennett has been appointed Deputy Director in Ottawa.
