Mr. Somchai Anuman-Rajadhon, this morning presented his Letter of Credence as first Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Thailand to Canada.

The ceremony took place at Government House at 11.00 A.M. Mr. Henry F. Davis, Chief of Protocol, Department of External Affairs, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor General. Mr. G. P. de T. Glazebrook, Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor General, were in attendance on the Governor General on this occasion.

The Ambassador was accompanied by Mr. Nissai Vejjajiva, Second Secretary.

Mr. Somchai has been in the Thai diplomatic service since 1942. He is at present Acting Permanent Representative of Thailand to the United Nations in New York, where he will continue to reside.
