- -- support for a comprehensive test ban treaty;
- -- prevention of an arms race in outer space; and
- -- the building of confidence sufficient to facilitate the reduction of military forces in Europe and elsewhere.

What is Canada's practical contribution to arms control? Here, there are three aspects:

- existing treaties. To deviate from full compliance with arms control and disarmament agreements is to threaten the basic credibility and viability of arms control. Canada has reiterated on a number of occasions the need for compliance by all parties with existing treaties to include the ABM treaty and SALT agreements. We believe nothing should be done to undercut their authority.
- -- Our second practical contribution is in the field of verification. This is an area where Canada is making a practical
