PRAYERS

Ordered,—That at 9.30 o'clock p.m. the Committee of the Whole on Bill C-49, An Act to amend the statute law relating to income tax, shall rise and report progress; and

That the House complete the second reading and reference to the Standing Committee on Transport and Communications of Bill C-48, An Act to amend the Railway Act; and

That proceedings under Standing Order 40 be suspended if debate on second reading of Bill C-48 has not been concluded by 10.00 o'clock p.m.

Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale), a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table,—Copies of Report entitled "Towards a Mineral Policy for Canada—Opportunities for Choice". (English and French).—Sessional Paper No. 301-4/63.

Mr. Kaplan, seconded by Mr. Stewart (Cochrane), by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-378, An Act respecting Women in Industry, which was read the first

time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

On motion of Mr. Sharp, seconded by Mr. Drury, it was ordered,—That the Standing Committee on External Affairs and National Defence be empowered to hear evidence on and to consider Canadian policy with respect to the question of continuing defence cooperation with the United States and in particular the future of the North American Air Defence agreement (NORAD); and

That the Standing Committee on External Affairs and National Defence be empowered to hear reports from Canadian delegations which have met with delegations from foreign parliaments or attended inter-parliamentary assemblies.

Bill C-49, An Act to amend the statute law relating to income tax, was again considered in Committee of the Whole.
