An Act to amend the Criminal Law relating to Violence, Threats and Molestations.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Criminal Law Preamble. relating to Violence, Threats and Molestation,; therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as 5 follows:—

- I. The Act of the thirty-eighth year of Her Majesty's 38 Vic., c. 39, Reign, Chapter thirty-nine, intituled "An Act to amend the repealed."

 Provisions of 'An Act to amend the Criminal Law relating to Violence, Threats and Molestation" is hereby repealed.
- 10 2. The first section of the Act of the thirty-fifth year of Sect. 1 of 35

 Her Majesty's Reigu, Chapter thirty-one, intituled "An Act repealed and to amend the Criminal Law relating to Violence. Threats and other provisions shall remain repealed, and the following provisions shall be substituted instead thereof, and shall here15 after be read as forming the first section of the said Act, which shall be construed accordingly:—
- "I. Every person who wrongfully and without legal Persons authority, with a view to compel any other person to abstain wrongfully from doing anything which he has a legal right to do, or to certain acts, 20 do anything from which he has a legal right to abstain,— viz:
 - "(1). Uses violence to such other person, or his wife or children, or injures his property; or—
- "(2.) Intimidates such other person, or his wife or children, by threats of using violence to him, her or any of them, or 25 of injuring his property; or—
 - "(3.) Persistently follows such other person about from place to place; or—
- "(4.) Hides any tools, clothes or other property owned or used by such other person, or deprives him, or hinders him 30 in the use thereof; or—
 - "(5.) Follows such other person with one or more other persons in a disorderly manner in or through any street or road; or—
