

24. To conclude, we wish to reiterate our support to the legislators who have undertaken to give Canada a capital which reflects its linguistic and cultural duality. However, we urge them to pay attention to the scream of alarm and the insecurity, increasingly obvious, of the Capital Region's francophones who have finally realized that by putting theory into prictice, the National Capital Commission's technicians might strangle the Ottawa region's French community.
