Motion No. 7A.

That Bill C-19, be amended in Clause 33 by striking out lines 37 to 40 at page 13 and substituting the following therefor:

“33.(1) This Act except this section and sections 3 and 9 shall come into force on a date prescribed by the Governor in Council after the implementation of regulations respecting the safe operation of extra-provincial bus undertakings or extra-provincial truck undertakings including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, regulation respecting audit, inspection, entry on premises and the provision of information, in at least 7 provinces.

(2) This section and sections 3 and 9, shall come into force on January 1, 1988 or on an earlier date as may be fixed by proclamation.”
