

Regulations respecting the granting of Lands in the Province of Lower Canada.

Executive Council Office, Quebec, 10th Oct. 1794.

WHEREAS several Warrants of Survey of the ungranted Lands of the Crown have been directed to be made out on behalf of divers persons who have applied for the same and their Associates. And whereas it is expedient that prior to the issuing of any Grant of Land, enquiry should be made into the Principles and Character of such persons as may be desirous of becoming Settlers in this Province, before they are admitted to take the Oaths and subscribe the Declaration by His Majesty's instructions directed to be required; PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, that for the purposes aforesaid, His Excellency GUY LORD DORCHESTER the Governor in Council has been pleased to nominate and appoint the following persons to be Commissioners, viz.
