ARTICLE X.

RESIGNATIONS—Sec. 1. All resignations of office or membership shall be made in writing addressed to the Secretary, to be submitted to the next regular meeting of the Club for action thereon.

Sec. 2. All dues must be paid in full before a resignation is considered.

ARTICLE XI.

VACANCIES--Should a vacancy occur among the Committee or other Officers, the Club shall appoint a successor.

ARTICLE XII.

REMOVAL OF OFFICERS—Any officer may for repeated negligence or dereliction of his duties, be removed from office by a vote of two-thirds of the members of the Club present at a special meeting.

ARTICLE XIII.

OPENING MEET.—The opening meet shall be held on the Saturday following Annual meeting or on any more convenient subsequent date that the Committee may fix.

ARTICLE XIV.

EXPULSIONS—Sec. I. Any member who may have been guilty of ungentlemanly conduct shall be liable to expulsion and may be expelled by a vote of two-thirds of the members present at a meeting of the Club specially called for that pur-
