RELICS.

1. Hat worn by Louis Riel at the battle of Batoche, 12th May, 1885, and given by him to one of the counsel for his defence.
2. Wooden hand. Part of a statue which was over the door of the Parish Church, on Place-d'Armes.
Seminary of St. Sulpice.
3. Photograph of the steamboat *Beaver*, the first steamer on the North Pacific; wrecked near Vancouver, in 1892; also, pieces of a hawser, wood, copper, etc., from her hull.

4. Piece of a beam from the ruins of Fort Senneville. Built, 1690; dismantled, 1775.
5. A section of a wooden pipe of the first waterworks of Montreal, 1801 to 1815.

6. Antique coffee urn found in the vaults of the old Seminary, Montreal.

7. Chief's war club, from one of the South Pacific Islands.
