Health TO BRAVE RAPIDS ON STILTS

Frank Bennett Thinks He Has Scientific Invention That Will Take Him Successfully Thru.

Niagara Falls, Oct. 29.-Frank Bennett, a stilt walker, proposes to walk thru the rapids at Niagara Falls from Goat Island to the New York side on Nov. 12. He declared that by an invention that he has perfected the very elements that he would brave will ald him in his perilous journey.

His plan is to weight a pair of stilts with about 120 pounds of lead to make them cling to the bottom of the water, well knowing that a single mis-step will be paid for by death. But he says that he has so shaped the weights on the bottom of his stilts that the pressure and velocity of the water will cause them to cling to the rocky bottom, and absolutely prevent his slipping or sliding to absolute destruction. 


