The above list of receipts shows a blank for Amherst, but their list for 1874 is very much larger than for 1873. Annapolis and Rosette have together sent a larger sum than last year. Bridgetown, from which nothing was received in 1873 has resumed its usual place on the lists. Dartmouth has a little exceeded the amount of last year. Glace Bay has sent us more in the present year than in the past. Guysboro also has nearly doubled its return. St. Mark's, Halifax, has sent this year its contribution separately from St. George's and seems to evince a growing interest in the D. C. S. New Ross, although heavily taxed for local objects has increased its return. Shelburne has made a still further advance in its contribution, being the largest ever sent from that parish. From several parishes and missions there have been no returns in consequence of changes of missionaries and we regret to notice that some who are well able have not come up to the usual mark.
