4. Return of ages, names, salaries, etc., of officers, clerks, messengers, etc.; Ordered, 150. Laid on the Table, 188-192.
5. Commissioners by *delimus potestatem* to administer oath to Members, 1.

7. Continues sitting after 12 o'clock, midnight, 84, etc.
