

First Meeting  
 how called.

III. And be it enacted, That the said members of the said body politic and corporate, shall hold their first meeting at such time and place as the said John Scoble and James C. Brown shall by notice in writing addressed to the said members respectively at their respective places of residence, and deposited for transmission in Her Majesty's Post Office in the Province, twenty-one days at least before the time for holding the said meeting appointed, and at such meeting or at any subsequent meeting to be held at such time and in such manner as the members present at the said first meeting may appoint and direct, it shall be lawful for the said members thereof, or a majority of those who may be in attendance at such meeting, to make all such Rules, Regulations and By-laws as they may think proper for the management of the affairs of the said Corporation, and for letting, selling, or otherwise disposing of the property thereof, and for the appointing of successors to supply the vacancies which may in any manner arise amongst the members of the said Corporation, so that the number may not at any time be reduced below five, and for the appointment of any other members of the said body politic and corporate, and generally in all other matters, to make such other Rules and Regulations, respecting the affairs of the said Institute as to them may deem meet; Provided always, that the Rules, Regulations and By-laws to be passed by the said body politic, shall be in accordance with the laws of this Province.
