recovered before any Justice of the Peace of the County or United Counties in which such toll-gate is situate.

Fines and for iditures how tevied.

III. And be it enacted, That the fines and forfeitures authorised to be imposed by this Act shall be levied and collected by distress and sale of the offender's goods and 5 chattels, under the authority of any warrant or warrants to be issued for that purpose by such Justice as aforesaid, or any other Justice of such County or United Counties, who is hereby empowered to grant the same.

Penalty on persons evading tolls.

IV. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons 10 shall after proceeding on the said road, with any of the carriages or animals liable to pay toll, turn out of the same road into any other road, and shall enter the said road beyond any of the said toll-gate or gates without paying toll, whereby such payment shall be evaded, such person 15 or persons shall for every such offence forfeit and pay the sum of *five shillings* to be recovered before any Justice of the Peace for the County or United Counties in which such road is situate shall lie.

Fines, &c., to be paid to Treusurer of County, &c. V. And be it enacted, That all fines and forfeit-20 ures collected under authority of this Act shall be paid to the Treasurer of the County or United Counties in which such road shall lie to be placed by him in his accounts to the credit of such County or United Counties.

Extent of Act. VI. And be it enacted, That this Act shall apply only 25 to Upper Canada.
