With reference to your letter of the 27th No. 5993. ultimo, I have to say that, as stated in a provious letter, the trail in the Peigan Indian reserve referred to appears. to have been in use before the land was set apart as a reserve. It also appears that no practical damage is done . to the reserve, and there is no reason why the road should not continue to be used. The Department, therefore, conours in the establishment of the said road allowance as a public highway, that is to say, the road allowance entering the reserve on its north boundary, in the southwest quarter of section 6, township 9, range 27, and leaving it again in the southwest quarter of section 1, township 9, range 28. as shown on the man plan which you have filed in the Department. The said road allowance to be one chain wide. I may add that no further action appears to be necessary in this matter.
