To the Secretary-

In order to prevent the cutting of
Timber in trespass, Mr. Agent McDonald requested that the
boundary lines of the Fisher's Grant Reserves, near Pictou,
N.S. be retraced.

The Agent estimates the cost of the re-survey
may be from \$12.00 to \$15.00. I think that from \$25.00
to \$30.00 should be estimated for this work.

I believe that no expense whatever, in the
nature of Surveys, has ever been incurred by this Dept.
in connection with the Reserves in question. I have no
doubt that the re-survey is very desirable, and would be very
useful, in order to enable the Agent to stop the cutting
of timber in trespass.

I beg to recommend that the Survey be made
as soon as funds are available.
