

records and documents as will permit full examination and audit to be made of the accounts relative to the expenditure.

14. It is agreed that statements of accounts for expenditures made by the Province when submitted for Dominion contribution pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement shall be accompanied by the certificate of the Provincial Auditor and be made on such form as the Dominion Commissioner of Unemployment Relief may direct from time to time.

15. It is understood and agreed that the Dominion shall not be liable to contribute to any claim of expenditure submitted by the Province under the terms of this agreement unless such claim is submitted within ninety days next after the last day of the month in which the expenditure described in the claim was incurred.

16. It is agreed that the Dominion Commissioner of Unemployment Relief may at any time direct an examination in connection with any distribution of aid contributed to under the terms of this agreement, and that the Province shall facilitate as fully as it can every such investigation.

17. It is agreed that the Province will furnish such statistical and other reports relative to matters connected with this Agreement as may be requested from time to time.

18. This Agreement shall be retroactive to April 1, 1938, including said date, and shall expire, in any event, not later than March 31, 1939.
