I beg to confirm the following telegram sent you yesterday, viz:-

- " Right cases small-pox reported at Sheguin-
- " dah. Quarantine and put man in charge to see
- " that regulations are observed. Two hundred vac-
- " cine points ordered."

I may add that you will be good enough to vaccinate all the Indians requiring it and take every precaution to prevent the spread of the disease and report to Mr. Agent Sims.
