
Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 20th Instant I beg to say that the total area of Cookburn Island is 42,135 acres, of which there remains undisposed of about 29,700 acres. The price of the land varies according to quality and location, but is mostly about 50 cents per acre, subject to settlement.

I enclose copy of the Land Regulations, which will give you full information as to improvements to be made and the quantity which any one purchaser may acquire.

The lands in this Township are in the hands of the local Agent, Mr. Robert Thorburn, of Gore Bay, from whom any further information desired, upon application, may be obtained.
