

15. The Field Officer-in-Waiting will ensure that the Motorcycle Escort and His Excellency's car are ready for the departure.
16. On arrival of the Procession at the Central Entrance (after His Excellency and Her Royal Highness have resumed their cloaks in their cloakrooms and the staff, except those in morning dress, have picked up their head dress), the Governor-General and Princess Alice will enter their motor-car and leave via the front of the East Block and the Central Gates, returning to Government House by the same route as that by which they came.
17. The Members of the Staff will return to Government House in the same cars as those in which they arrived.
18. DRESS: Morning clothes or Service Dress. Her Royal Highness and the Ladies of the Staff will wear afternoon dresses. Members of the Staff will leave all headgear in their cloakrooms, subject to paragraph 4.
19. On the return to Government House a group photograph will be taken under arrangements made by the Comptroller.
