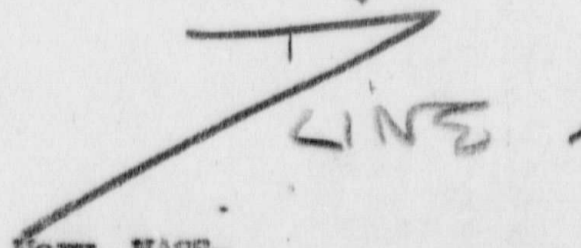

Cabins.
