We wish to call the attention of the Government to the conditions of this place. The upper part of the harbor is so shoal that fishermen who have their boats there are greatly handicapped in getting up and down, and can only do so at half tide. The small channel through which they have to pass is almost filled up, and what is needed is the dredge to deepen this channel. Boats have been obliged to wait outside for hours with their fish catch as the bars on the outside are too shoal to get in over, and we trust the Government will send the dredge in the early spring as those fishing at the lower part of the harbor have to run the boats to the upper, and in rough weather to save them from damage. In the recent storm a large fishing boat belonging to Thomas Kane was very much damaged, and several other driven ashore. We cannot understand why other places get so much public utilities and we haven't even a Government wharf. The fishermen of this place are an industrious, hardworking lot to whom Government relief is repugnant, but the least that should be done is to send the dredge and make a channel to facilitate the work in getting to and from their fisherman rooms.

Science Studies Effects of Moon on Plant Life

Another ancient "myth" of mankind begins, too, to raise its head in the most unmythical precincts of science. This is the millennium-old belief in some special effect of the moon on life. There are still farmers in Virginia and Carolina who plant their crops religiously according to the phases of the moon. "Bank superstition," says the dogmatist. Perhaps that is right. Science has always believed so. To believe in the effects of the moon was lunacy. But perhaps not. About four years ago some scientists, not in the least lunatic, began to discover that certain living creatures, notably some kinds of seaweed and some species of ocean-dwelling worms, possessed a distinct lunar periodicity. They fruited or bred or came to the surface or did other quite definite things in exact correspondence with the phases of the moon. It seemed almost as though they had an almanac. Now there has come to light another fact that seems likely to explain this one.

It has been found that the kind of light called polarized light is more effective in certain of the chemical process of life than is ordinary light. Moonlight is partly polarized. It is composed, in part, of this same kind of light which scientists now find peculiar in its actions on living matter. Possibly moonlight really does have a different effect on plants and animals than does sunlight decreased to the same intensity. This would explain the apparent moon-knowledge of the sea worms and the sea weeds. It would restore another ancient legend of mankind to an honored place among the truths of observation.
