KATE HASKETT'S DEATH

AN ABSENT DOCTOR DEPARTS THE INQUEST A DAY LONGER. And HASKETT'S DEATH—Miss HASKETT'S DEATH—Miss HASKETT'S DEATH.

KATE HASKETT'S DEATH. Last night at the morgue Coroner Phillips made another step in the inquest touching the death of Kate Haskett who was found drowned in a cistern in rear of No. 42 Isabella street on Monday morning last.

KATE HASKETT'S DEATH. There was a good prop of evidence in the inquest, but when they came down to the medical testimony it was found that Dr. Johnson, who had the details of the post mortem examination in his possession, was missing, and the inquest had to be further adjourned until to-night. Several witnesses were examined. It was shown in evidence that a person could get into the cistern and close down the lid after them.

KATE HASKETT'S DEATH. The "lid" which fell itself, a broken pipe was behind it. One of the witnesses had no reason to believe that Miss Haskett had been crossed in love; that she had ever heard of an engagement having been broken. She was a very jolly girl. Miss Mary Madden, who had known Miss Haskett since she was a child, testified that she had seen her on the Sunday before Miss Haskett disappeared. Deceased told her that she felt unwell, and believed that a disease she had had seven years ago was coming back on her. She did not mention the nature of the disease. Deceased said to witness, "Do you ever think of making away with yourself, Mary?" Witness answered, "No, I never think of such a question." She then said, "Mary, I often feel as if I could go and drown myself."

KATE HASKETT'S DEATH. Dr. Johnson in the post mortem, as they had found all the principal organs in a healthy condition. There was a constriction 1 1/2 inches in diameter on the right parietal bone. This wound was made before death and could have been inflicted by the lid of the cistern falling on the head. The wound was sufficient to cause insensibility. The dissection showed that death was caused by an abscess of water from the lungs and stomach from the fact that after the body was taken out of the cistern it lay on the ground face downwards with the feet elevated on the box of the cistern. As Dr. Johnson could not remember all the details of the post mortem (Dr. Johnson having taken the notes) he would not give positive conclusions put to him by the coroner and jury.
