

The Association has received from Mr. James Canfield, Local Registrar at Woodstock, a photograph of the new Court House at Woodstock, and from Mr. T. S. Shenston, Registrar of Brant, a copy of his new work on the Registry Act.

Complaints have frequently been made of the use of the Barristers' Room by litigants and witnesses. A suitable room for litigants and witnesses is provided on the side of the hall immediately opposite the library.

Attention is once more drawn to the anomaly existing in reference to orders issued from the offices of the Deputy-Clerk and Deputy-Registrar here. On all orders issued in the former office a fee of 50c. only is charged, whereas in the latter the fee is \$1.50. This matter has been brought to the attention of the Government, and will be further pressed till the injustice is abolished.
