Full returns of the municipal elections in England show a Liberal gain 97, and a Conservative gain of 66.

The members of the colonial cabinet have resigned in consequence of the passage of a vote of want of confidence by the Victoria Parliament.

An Association has been formed in London with the intention of opposing the Lloyds. It has perfected its arrangements and adopted the title of "British Corporation for Survey and Registry of Shipping."

Captain Grombtshevski, the explorer, has returned to St. Petersburg from his expedition to the Hindoo-Koosh. His survey covered 7,000 yersts. Abundant geographical and ethnographical data were secured.

Three thousand strikers at Sydney, N. S. W, have declared in favor of continuing their struggle. The miners of Newcistle are resuming work. There has been rioting in Adelaide caused by Unionists molesting non-Union men.

Startling evidence has been discovered in the case of Daniel Gorrie, who was hanged a few weeks ago for the murder of a fellow workman in a bakery at Herne Hill, England. Gerrie stoutly maintained his innocence to the last, and now facts have come to the knowledge of the authorities showing that he was guiltless of the crime.
