"The Conference agrees that during the period in between the entry interpretent force of the Convention for the World Meteorological Organization and the first meeting of the Congress of the World Meteorological Organization, the International Meteorological Organization shall carry on its usual functions through its established bodies and under its existing financial arrangements in order to ensure the necessary continuity in the world-wide cooperation of meteorological services."

The Conference also adopted a number of resolutions based on recommend^{s'} tions of its Commissions.

The final session of the Conference was held on October 11, 1947.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the Directors of the following Meteorological Services Members of the International Meteorological Organization, or their alternates of observers, sign this Final Act.

DONE at Washington, this eleventh day of October, 1947, in the English and French languages, each equally authentic, the original of which shall be deposited in the archives of the Government of the United States of America. The Government of the United States of America shall transmit certified copies thereof all the Governments of those Directors of Meteorological Services represented at the present Conference.
