The transcontinental railways — the Canadian Pacific and the Canadian National — came first. (The CP's last spike was driven at Craigelleaichie, B.C., November 7, 1885.). They were joined in this century by aeroplanes, telephones, radio and television. (The sedate train passengers pictured are listening to one of the first radio broadcasts.) The National Film Board, founded by John Grierson in 1939, continues to turn out first-rate documentaries. 


