BILATERAL ECONOMIC/COMMERCIAL CONSULTATIONS WERE HELD WITH COLOMBIAN COUNTERPARTS IN BOGOTA OVER TWO DAYS IN MID-FEB. (2) THE COMMERCIAL SECTION TOOK RESPONSIBILITY FOR GROUND-WORK/LOGISTICS, ASSISTED IN PREPARATION OF BRIEFING MATERIAL, HOSTED A NINE-MEMBER INTERDEPARTMENTAL CDN DELEGATION LED BY MICHAEL BELL, ADM-LATIN AMERICA & THE CARIBBEAN, AND ENSURE FOLLOW-UP AFTER THE MEETINGS CONCLUDED. (3) THE BOGOTA METRO PROJECT (CCC/LAVALIN) CONTINUED TO DRAW SIGNIFICANTLY ON STAFF RESOURCES DURING THE REPORTING PERIOD AS DID THE JUSTICE DEPT. COMPUTARIZATION PROJECT, ABSORBING APPROXIMATELY 25 TO 30% OF THE TIME OF ONE CANADA-BASED OFFICER AND ABOUT 10 TO 15% OF THE TIME OF THE PROGRAM MANAGER.
