Statistics Canada actively participates in several international expert groups focused on measuring progress toward the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). This participation has helped all countries, including developing countries, to develop robust statistics and indicators for measuring progress toward achieving the 2030 Agenda.

In 2017-2018, Statistics Canada also continued to serve on several task forces in support of the SDGs in United Nations bodies such as the United Nations Statistics Division, the United Nations

Economic Commission for Europe; the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization; and the United Nations Environment Programme.

Through such participation, Statistics Canada contributes significantly to the development of global indicators for measuring progress toward the SDGs, including in developing countries.
