

MARION ADAMS MACPHERSON

Miss Macpherson was born in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan on May 16, 1924. She is a graduate of the University of Saskatchewan (B.A.) and of the University of Toronto (M.A.) During 1946 and 1947 she was a research assistant, first with the Government of Saskatchewan and then with the University of Toronto.

Miss Macpherson joined the Department of External Affairs in 1948 and served with the Canadian diplomatic mission in Washington from 1950 to 1954. From 1956 to 1958 she served with the International Commission for Supervision and Control in Hanoi (Vietnam) as Adviser, and was subsequently posted to the Canadian mission in Accra (Ghana) from 1958 to 1959. In 1963, Miss Macpherson was appointed Counsellor to the Canadian Permanent Mission to the United Nations. In February 1971, Miss Macpherson became Director of the United Nations Political and Institutional Affairs Division.
